20 issues from the period 1940 - 1970. The earlier issues are in German

Fiberarts

Almost complete for the periods 1979 - 1984 and 1987 - 1991. A few issues outside those periods.
Covers all textile art and craft.

Hali

107 (Nov/Dec 1999). Main articles on the Pazyryk Carpet and Russian Printed Cottons of Central Asia

Handwoven

Approx 50% of issues 1986 - 1990, and a few odd issues since then.

The successor to Weaver's, more beginners' weaving, mostly four shafts or less, and very little for upwards of eight shafts.

Interlink - Creative Textile Crafts Magazine

1-1 - 2-3 (1983 - 1984). Edited by Mike Halsey

Interweave

1979/1-4, 1980/1-4; 1981/1

American magazine covering weaving, spinning and tapestry, at an intermediate or special interest level.

Practical Weaving Suggestions

Miscellaneous between 1-57 and 4-60

Selvedge

All issues from issue 5 (April/May 2005)

Covers a wide swathe of the textile world internationally but with a strong emphasis on UK. Includes good coverage of weaving at the professional maker/exhibition level. Some issues themed.

Shuttle, Spindle, Dyepot

Very few issues before 1988. From 1988 to the present we have more issues than we are missing, but by no means every issue is there.

Official journal of the Handweaver's Guild of America. Despite the title, it's almost entirely weaving-related - there's very little dyeing and only marginally more spinning.

Spin-Off

Most issues 1996 - 2003; one or two issues outside that period.

Deals with spinning but also includes weaving and knitting using handspun yarns

The Journal for Weavers, Spinners & Dyers 1952 - 1973

All issues, bound into annual volumes.

The Journal for Weavers, Spinners & Dyers 1974 -

All issues

The Prairie Wool Companion

All issues (1-16; 1981 - 1987)

Also referred to as PWC. Metamorphosed after issue 16 into Weaver's. Themed issues contain many seminal articles.

Threads

A handful of issues from the late eighties, including the premier issue. The early issues covered weaving, tapestry, knitting as well as sewing, which is why we have them.

Warp and Weft

All issues since vol 1/no 1, April 1951. Up to 1985 in bound volumes.
